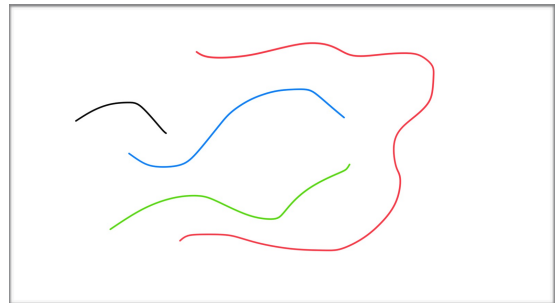


Impressionism in art and music for under fives and families

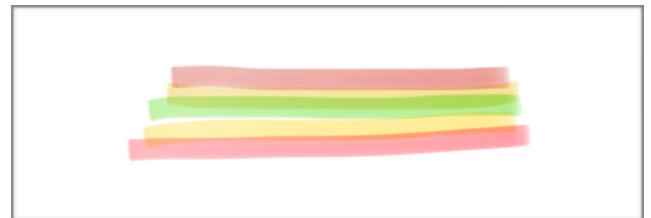
Phrasing and shapes

Activity: Try singing long and short phrases and drawing them. Take your pencil for a walk around the paper whilst singing long phrases.



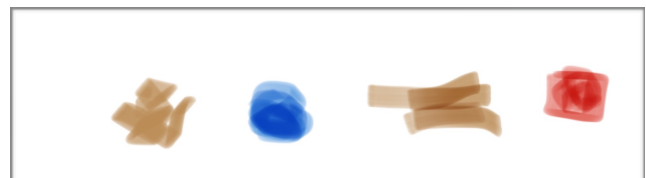
Harmony and colour

Activity: Make up sounds for colours. Get two or three people to make different sounds. Record it and listen back to hear what colours of sounds you are making.



Tone and texture

Activity: Explore pitch and resonance in the voice, head and chest. Try drawing the sounds you have created.



Tempo and mood

Activity:

Draw at different speeds see what effect it has.

Draw to music of varying speeds.

Try using short and long lines to represent speed.



Articulation and edges

Activity: Say or invent some words with hard and soft sounds, explore vowels and consonants. Try drawing your words.

Listen to a piece that is smooth or short and explore drawing in response to it.
